

COLOURED SHIRTS REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

In the case of Club coloured shirts, the design and colour of the shirts need to be registered by the Club with, and approved by, Bowls Wiltshire. (Registration forms are obtainable on request from the Administrator).

It is a requirement that if coloured shirts are to be worn by Club players, then the same colour must be worn by all members of the team or side, or not worn by any members.

If an event is sponsored, logos of a conflicting sponsor will not be worn, unless approved by the event

Basic Guidelines:

1. The shirt shall have a collar.
2. The shirt can be long or short sleeved (or Clubs may use a mixture of the two).
3. Any logo, wording, picture or any other form of reproduction associated with the business or name of the sponsor, or a Club badge will be contained within an area of not more than 150 sq cm, i.e. 12.5 cm x 12.5 cm or 15 cm x 10 cm, etc. The proportioned positioning of such advertising material or logo or badge shall be clearly shown on the diagram of the shirt submitted for approval.
4. The name of the Club may be printed on the back of the shirt at shoulder blade level in lettering no more than 40 mm in height. Only one horizontal line of letters may be used. This lettering is not part of the 150 sq cm.

Note: To make changes to a registered and approved coloured shirt will require a written submission to, and written approval from, Bowls Wiltshire.
